Clothing & Essentials

 - Pajamas & undergarments

Beach & Outdoor Gear

You'll spend most of your time outside, so come prepared:

- Beach towels (if not provided)
- Beach chairs or blankets
- Umbrella or pop-up tent
- Beach bag

- Sunscreen (reef-safe recommended) & lip balm with SPF
 - Aloe or after-sun lotion
 - Bug spray (important for marshy areas)
 - Reusable water bottles
 - Cooler for drinks/snacks
 - Sand toys / boogie boards
 - Frisbee, football, or paddleball

Island Living Must-Haves

Fripp has its own rhythm—these items help you settle right in:

- Golf cart accessories (phone holder, charger, small speaker)
 - Bike helmets (if bringing/renting bikes)
 - Daypack or tote for exploring
 - Flashlight or headlamp (great for evening walks)
 - Camera

Toiletries & Personal Items

Some rentals provide basics, but it's best to bring your own:

- Shampoo, conditioner, body wash
- Toothbrushes & toothpaste
- Hairbrush / styling tools
- Medications & basic first aid kit
- Laundry pods (handy for longer stays)



Kitchen & Grocery Starters

If you're staying in a vacation rental, a few extras go a long way:

- Coffee & filters (or pods)
- Snacks for the kids
- Breakfast staples
- Spices or favorite condiments
- Zip-top bags / foil
- Paper towels & extra trash bags



Kid-Specific Items

Keep it fun and stress-free:

- Favorite snacks & drinks
- Books, coloring supplies, or small games
- Tablets/headphones for downtime
- Nightlight (helpful in a new place)
- Pool floats or noodles
- Baby gear if needed (pack 'n play, monitor, stroller)



Traveling with Pets

Fripp is a great place to bring your four-legged family members, just be sure they're comfortable and beach-ready too:

- Leash, collar, and ID tags
 - Crate or bed for sleeping
 - Food & treats (plus bowls)
 - Waste bags
 - Favorite toys or comfort items
 - Towels for sandy paws
 - Grooming brush
 - Pet-safe sunscreen (for light-coated dogs)
 - Vaccination records (just in case)
